The Graduate Leadership Council (GLC) and Graduate Student Councils from CAS, Kogod, SIS, SOC, and SPA will select outstanding students to present their research, project, or other piece of work in a symposium-style setting on campus. You must be a graduate student at American University in good standing (3.0 minimum GPA), and available to present your research or project in a symposium-style setting for the duration of the reception on April 14, 2018 from 11:00am – 2:00pm. You can submit your research or project on any topic; however, we seek to recognize students whose research focuses on innovative topics that address the world's emerging challenges. You must be comfortable presenting your work on a poster board. Easels will be provided by the GLC.
